- New table fan in the kids bedroom


Where to Park at Seascape

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• You will have one unassigned parking space under the South Beach building. You may only park under this building and have your parking pass displayed at all times or you will be ticketed.

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- There are luggage carts to help you take your personal items up to the unit located inside the building to the left of the elevator.
 - Beach gear is not allowed in the unit or the building per HOA. All beach chairs, umbrellas, and toys need to stay in the car.
- The garage is 6'3" so if you have a larger vehicle, you may need to park around the perimeter of our building.
- If you need to bring an extra vehicle for any reason, there is on street parking all around Seapointe Village. You will need to download the "Park Mobile" app and from there you can pay for our spot. I believe the fee is \$2/hour with a max of 5 hours at a time. You can always add more time from your phone if the vehicle is parked for longer that. There is some free parking along Seaview Ave that you may want to look at first.
- If you leave Seapointe, there is an exit in the back behind the Centre Court building that will take you out onto Seaview Ave. You can only exit there, you will not be able to get back in as you would need an owners card. So just remember, if you exit from there, that's fine – the gate will open but when you return, you will need to come through the main entrance at the gate house so that the security guard can let you in.



House Rules

No parties (no loud music after 9pm).

Absolutely no pets or animals of any kind at any time.

This is a non-smoking complex and unit. Please do not smoke in or near the unit or you will be asked to leave. This includes the balcony.

Respect the neighbors.

Report damages immediately.

Guests of guests are welcome but need to be registered with us.

Please empty all garbage daily. There is a garbage drop at the end of the hallway near the elevators.

No beach equipment in the house or the building.

Please do not hang anything from the railings of the balcony.

Spray all suntan lotion on outside. It stains the carpet and makes the tile very slippery.

No candles in the unit or on the blacony.

Should any problems arise during your stay please get in touch with me immediately and I will do my utmost to resolve any issues.

POOL TAGS

There are 6 pool tags in the unit that you will need to use if you are going to any one of the 4 pools on the property or to the beach. While they rarely check for them on the beach, it's important to bring them just in case. You will also need a pool tag with you if you decide to use the fitness center located in the Pinnacle building.

LINENS

At this time, we are not providing sheets for the beds due to the early check out time and also for the protection of our guests due to Covid.

In the unit there is one king bed and 4 twins including one set of bunk beds, a twin bed and a foldaway twin bed that can go anywhere.

We do supply blankets, pillows and bath towels (including wash clothes, hand towels and body towels) but we ask that you wash everything that you use prior to departure. If additional laundry or dry cleaning is needed as a result of things not being washed, there will be an additional charge.

PACKING LIST

WATER

We do have a Brita in the unit so you are welcome to use that or bring your own bottled water.

There is also a refilling station located in the Pinnacle building which is the building directly behind the ocean front pool if you want to bring water bottles with you to the pool.

GRILLS

There are new Weber Grills throughout the Village that are open for use from noon until 8:30pm if you want to bring anything to grill. There are also table and chairs throughout the resort so that you can dine outside by the pools or ocean if you wish.





GROCERIES

If you are staying for a week or more, we highly recommend getting grocery delivery. It will save you the time and stress of having to purchase all the groceries ahead of time and pack them in the car. There are several places nearby that will deliver directly to the door at Seascape. For additional information on these options, please click on the link above.



BEACH THINGS

Beach gear is not allowed in the unit. All beach chairs, umbrellas, and toys need to stay in the car. The HOA does not allow beach stuff on the elevators or in the hallways due to the sand. I personally find it very easy to leave the beach stuff in our car since it's so close to the beach.

If you want to just rent beach equipment, Seapointe makes it very easy. They have chairs and umbrellas for rent at the Deli Hut and if you rent them for 5 days or more, you get a 15% discount off the total. They will set up the chairs and the umbrella anywhere you want it and then also take it down each night for you. You don't have to do anything! Rental rates are \$8/day for a chair and \$11/day for an umbrella. I believe it's cash only so just wanted you to know that so you brought some cash with you.


COFFEE

We do have a Keurig so if you are coffee drinkers and want to bring your k cups, there is that option. We also have a standard coffee maker as well.

The deli hut opens at 7am and has great breakfast options if you want to grab a cup of coffee and head to the beach for breakfast.







Household Information

NETFLIX

We do have a Netflix account for the condo. If you want to watch a Netflix movie, you are welcome to use the house account. Each tv is already logged in to Netflix for you to make it easier.

THERMOSTAT

The thermostat can be adjusted simply by selecting "Mode" and then putting the temperature to where you are comfortable. We would prefer you limit it to between 68 and 73 degrees.

MAINTENANCE

If you find that you need lightbulbs or batteries, they are in the cabinet above the fridge. There are also additional Brita filters if you would like to replace the one in there for added safety.

ATM

If you need an ATM, there is one located in the guest services office in the Seapointe realty offices in front of the guard house. The fee there though is \$3.99!

POTS AND PANS

The pots and pans are dishwasher safe.

GAMES AND BOOKS

There are several games in the living room for you to use including cards, Yahtzee, Dominos, and more. There are also several books if you want to borrow one while you are there.

MEDICAL HELP

- We do have a first aid kit with the basics (Neosporin, band-aids, butterflys, etc) in the top drawer of the bathroom cabinets in the master bath.
- If you should need more extensive first aid, there is a first aid station located in the Aquatics office near lbis. The phone number is 609-522-1818. Their hours are 9am to 5pm.
- Should you need a physician, there is physician care available at Crest Medical Associates, 6410 New Jersey Ave in Wildwood Crest. Their phone number is 609-523-1331.
- The closest hospital is Cape Regional located just west of exit 10 off the Garden State Parkway.




FAMILY FRIENDLY RESTAURANTS

Here is our short list of favorites -


- Willow Creek Winery the pork bbq on a pretzel roll is out of this world with the smoky flavor and the habanero bbq sauce! Amazing!

Check Out Process

CHECK OUT AT 10 AM

- Check out will be at 10am on your departure date
- Please leave pool tags on the dining room table for the next guests. Missing tags cost \$100/piece to replace
- Please lock the door when you leave
- Please make sure all laundry is dried and put away. Nothing should be left in the dryer. Laundry not dried and put away may result in additional cleaning fees that we want to avoid.
- Please also make sure all dishes are washed and put away for the next guest. Dishes not washed and put away may result in additional cleaning fees that we want to avoid.
- Please take out all garbage prior to leaving.
- The unit should be broom swept and beds made prior to leaving.







The unit must be broom swept. There is a stick vacuum in the closet if you would like to use it.

All bedding must be placed back on the beds in a neat and orderly way.

All garbage must be removed from the unit prior to leaving. This includes all trash from the trash cans, garbage in the showers (empty soap boxes, razors, soap, etc) and empty beverage containers in the rooms. If anything spilled in the trashcans, please clean it up prior to leaving.

Any personal belonging must be removed including those from the showers, the dresser drawers and the refrigerator. Anything left behind will be thrown out.

The lint door must be cleaned out from the dryer and the lid to the washing machine should be left open.

All laundry needs to be washed, folded and put away in the same condition it was found upon arrival.

All dishes need to be washed and put away and the dishwasher should be clean and free of any food residue.

The Keurig needs to be cleaned of any remaining coffee k cups.

Please make sure all pool passes are hanging up. Missing passes are \$100 per band to replace.

If there was any damage to the unit, please make sure to notify us. Accidents happen and we understand that but no one likes surprises.

There is no expectation that you leave prior to 10am but should you decide to leave earlier, we just ask that you let us know so that we can let the cleaning team know that the unit is ready for turnover.
